All-Day Seminar in Birmingham (Saturday 27 March 2010)

GUEST SPEAKER

Dr Derek Tidball, former Principal of the London School of Theology (formerly London Bible College), chair of the Council of the Evangelical Alliance UK, President of the Baptist Union in 1990-91 and a Vice-President of the Evangelical Alliance. He has published in the fields of sociology of religion, theology and Evangelicalism, is Visiting Scholar at Spurgeon's College, London, and speaks widely at seminaries and colleges across the UK and US.

TOPIC AND PROGRAMME

Dr Tidball will be exploring the history, theology and current challenges facing Evangelicalism in the West, focusing on the UK and North America. Issues such as Evangelical responses to secularism, postmodernism, and Islam, as well as the emerging church and the Church's engagement with politics and culture will all be covered over the four sessions. As such, this is an important opportunity not to be missed by KEDS students, particularly those enrolled on the M.A. and B.Th. programmes. The day will consist of four sessions lasting 45-50 minutes, allowing for questions after each. The programme is as follows:

Getting There By Road. The hotel is within easy reach of the motorway network (M6, M5, M40 and M42 are all nearby), located at the National Exhibition Centre (NEC). From the M6 exit at J4, or from the M42 exit at J6, then follow the signs for the NEC. The hotel is located near the north car park. There is free parking for seminar attendees, but please inform if you require a space so we can make the necessary parking reservations.

By Rail. Nearest railway station is Birmingham International, a mile or so from the hotel.

By air. The hotel is 1.8 miles from Birmingham International Airport. From the airport take the free monorail to Birmingham International railway station (see above). Alternative, a taxi from the airport to the hotel costs about £5.
